

Tips

1. First of all clear all the basic concepts from N.C.E.R.T (or any state board)
2. Remember all basic formulas and just solve *miscellaneous* exercise from N.C.E.R.T
3. Apart from N.C.E.R.T there are few extra topics which you need to cover for JEE (eg. A-GP {Arithmetico-Geometric progression}) which you will get in any reference books.
4. Then go reference book which you are using(*i prefer cengage/arihant/mac graw hill{TATA PUBLICATIONS}*) and start with basic M.C.Q's and then go for moderate & then difficult.
5. After solving it just see previous year question(*it will help you to get confidence*) and try to solve it **(IN EACH PROCESS U PLZ TAKE CARE OF TIMING)**

JUST TRY TO STICK ON TIMINGS GIVEN BELOW:

- FOR EASY LVL QUESTIONS : <5 min
- FOR MODERATE LVL QUESTIONS : <8 MIN
- FOR DIFFICULT LVL QUESTIONS : <15 MIN
