

\Rightarrow Let $\Delta = \begin{vmatrix} Ax & x^2 & 1 \\ By & y^2 & 1 \\ Cz & z^2 & 1 \end{vmatrix}$ and $\Delta_1 = \begin{vmatrix} A & B & C \\ x & y & z \\ zy & zx & xy \end{vmatrix}$, then

(A) $\Delta_1 = -\Delta$

(B) $\Delta \neq \Delta_1$

(C) $\Delta - \Delta_1 = 0$

(D) None of these

Solution: (C) is the correct answer since

$$\begin{aligned}
 \Delta_1 &= \begin{vmatrix} A & B & C \\ x & y & z \\ zy & zx & xy \end{vmatrix} = \begin{vmatrix} A & x & yz \\ B & y & zx \\ C & z & xy \end{vmatrix} = \frac{1}{xyz} \begin{vmatrix} Ax & x^2 & xyz \\ By & y^2 & xyz \\ Cz & z^2 & xyz \end{vmatrix} \\
 &= \frac{xyz}{xyz} \begin{vmatrix} Ax & x^2 & 1 \\ By & y^2 & 1 \\ Cz & z^2 & 1 \end{vmatrix} = \Delta
 \end{aligned}$$
