## **Tips and Tricks**

- For organic chemistry, try to understand the mechanism of a given reaction instead of remembering the solution of every reaction you see. Using that mechanism, try to solve many similar reaction problems so that the mechanism settles down in your mind.
- Try to do as many previous years' JEE problems related to organic chemistry, keep an eye on the topics from which the questions are frequently asked in JEE, and revise them if you are not very confident.
- Read the NCERT book carefully and make your notes summarizing all important formulae and concepts in a single sheet. Remember all the exceptions as they can be used in making tricky questions in JEE.
- Always try to the questions at least two-three times using your knowledge; use your notes for reference before referring to the solution.
- Do not hesitate to ask your doubts, but before asking any doubts related to the question, at least try it once to know your doubts clearly (that is what you are trying to ask).
