

# Tips And Tricks

Give equal weightage to every chapter. (For JEE Mains)

Make short notes for every chapter so that you can do a quick revision before the exams.

Make a formula booklet and try to revise it daily. In JEE Mains 75% questions are direct formula based.

Try to give as many mock tests as possible before the exam. You should attempt mock tests in same time slot of actual JEE mains or advanced. Also analyze the mock test after attempting it.

3 Important strategies to attempt the paper-

1. Time Management

2. Accuracy

3. Selection of Question

According to me the best sequence for solving the paper should be

1. Chemistry

2. Physics

3. Math

You can switch between Physics and Math but try to attempt chemistry first.

Ask doubts only after you have attempted the question thoroughly.
