Question: 01

Let $A = \begin{pmatrix} [x+1] & [x+2] & [x+3] \\ [x] & [x+3] & [x+3] \\ [x] & [x+2] & [x+4] \end{pmatrix}$, where $[t]$ denotes the greatest integer less than or equal to

t. If $\det(A) = 192$, then the set of values of x is the interval :

- A. $[68, 69)$
- B. $[62, 63)$
- C. $[65, 66)$
- D. $[60, 61)$

Solutions

Solution: 01

Explanation

$$\begin{vmatrix} [x+1] & [x+2] & [x+3] \\ [x] & [x+3] & [x+3] \\ [x] & [x+2] & [x+4] \end{vmatrix} = 192$$

$$R_1 \rightarrow R_1 - R_3 \text{ \& } R_2 \rightarrow R_2 - R_3$$

$$\begin{bmatrix} 1 & 0 & -1 \\ 0 & 1 & -1 \\ [x] & [x]+2 & [x]+4 \end{bmatrix} = 192$$

$$2[x] + 6 + [x] = 192 \Rightarrow [x] = 62$$
